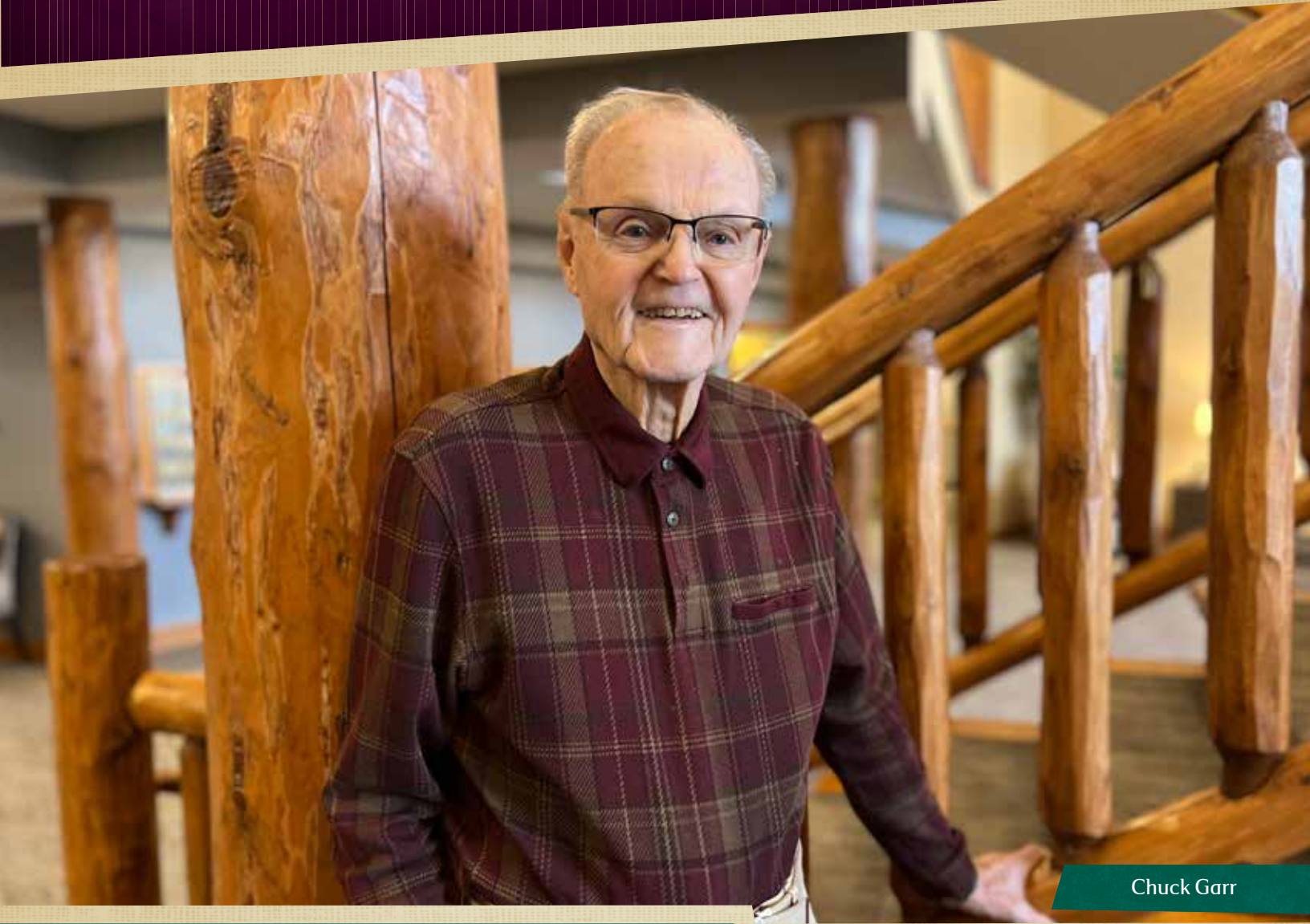

Jerry and Carol Ekblad Bring Smiles Home

"We like to have fun, and it makes us feel good to know we can bring a smile to others." - Jerry and Carol Ekblad



In 2016, when Jerry needed a wheelchair, Carol began searching for their next home. She was familiar with Waverly Gardens since Jerry's brother had lived there, and thought, "I do like it there. Jerry can play cards, swim, and do something every single day." Now, eight years later, she says, "It's a wonderful place and I'm so happy we're here together. Otherwise, it would have been me living in the house and him living someplace else. I didn't want that."

The couple has been together since they were teenagers, and that wasn't about to change. Jerry remembers the night they met, saying, "I saw her across the room, decorating for our church's ice cream social, and thought, I kinda like her." Carol continues, "I never knew, after that night, we'd be together for 70 years! Well, we've been married for 65 years, but we had to get our degrees first."

Carol earned her degree in nursing from Hamline University and Jerry received his degree in Business Administration from the University of Minnesota. But things hadn't started in that direction.

As a 15-year-old, because his father was blind, Jerry helped with his insurance business, driving him to appointments, taking notes, and looking up rates. Then, when Jerry turned 19, his father passed away. His mother continued the business, which allowed Jerry to pursue a degree and serve on active duty in the National Guard.

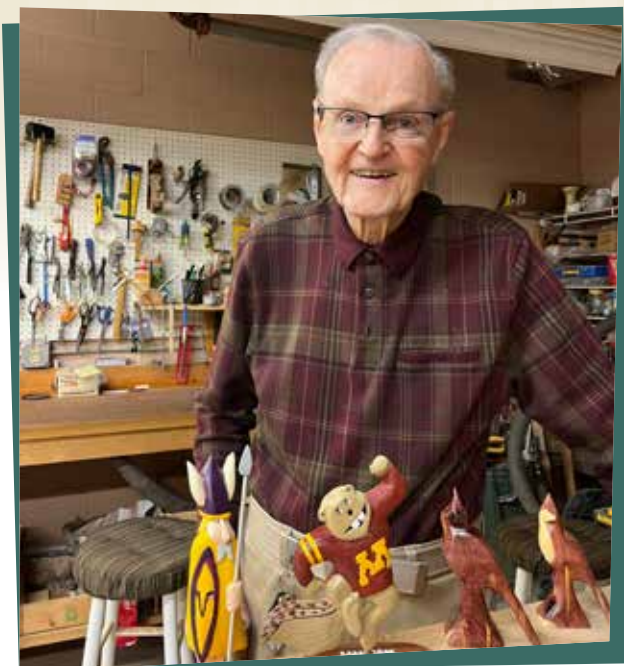
However, Jerry realized he enjoyed client interactions when helping his dad, so he changed majors, obtained his license, and returned to the family business. For the next 62 years, he grew his father's business into Ekblad, Pardee & Bewell - an agency with 20 employees.

Carol was a hospital nurse before joining the insurance industry, providing client physicals for 26 years. Her heart for people was demonstrated through extensive volunteerism as an event planner for Maplecrest Homeowner's Association and other community organizations, including Red Cross Blood Mobiles and Regions Hospital Birth Center. She especially enjoyed serving as a lay minister to homebound church members, bringing them communion and encouragement.

Jerry's volunteerism spanned 55 years, helping raise funds for the Lions Club, Rotary Club, Boy Scouts, and others. "I rented my first office from an attorney," recalls Jerry. "The first day there he said, 'C'mon! We're going to a Lions' meeting.' So, I went. The Lions Club taught me that lots of people need help, and we need to give it. We're blessed that way, but many people aren't."

Generosity has always been part of the Ekblads' lives. "We just gave to church when we were young," Jerry shares. "When my allowance increased from 25 to 35 cents, I thought, 'Oh, good! More candy! But my father said, 'No, you put that in the church offering.' So, I began early, and today we're happy to support Presbyterian Homes. We love to bring in programs that people enjoy," they say, "and we want to give neighbors something extra to look forward to."

Chuck Garr Finds Joy in Generosity

The prayer in Chuck Garr's pocket is his philosophy for life. "Lord, help me to be grateful for what I have, to remember that I don't need most of what I want, and that joy is found in simplicity and generosity."

When Harriet Garr volunteered in the late 1950s at Johanna Shores, the original Presbyterian Home, it didn't occur to her that she might live in a PHS community someday. But over 50 years later, she and her husband, Chuck, did just that. "When she volunteered at Johanna Shores, she thought Presbyterian Homes was just the best place in the world! She was impressed by it then, so when we came back to Minnesota in 2010, we moved into one of their townhomes at Timber Hills."

The Garrs had already spent many years in Minnesota, raising two sons. Employed by the telephone company, Chuck traveled throughout the entire state. "They educated me and sent me to all kinds of training. At the time of the Cold War, I worked at the Air Force Radar Base in Wadena, Minn., installing the SAGE system, which allowed airborne pilots to talk to the radar operators. After various assignments, I was sent to New Jersey to attend Electronic Switching School for six months. Upon completion, I returned to Minnesota and worked on a new phone system for the Mayo Clinic and other assignments until retirement."

Not long after he retired, Chuck and Harriet moved to Florida but returned each summer to go fishing at their Minnesota cabin. So, when it was time to move back to Minnesota full-time and be near their sons again, they were pleased to find a cabin-like feel at Timber Hills. Unfortunately, Harriet passed away less than a year later, after a long battle with cancer.

Chuck moved from the townhouse to independent living and then, after facing health challenges of his own, transitioned to assisted living. His days are still filled with purpose, often spending hours in the woodshop, creating a myriad of characters and critters, for which he is well known. During Timber Hills' Lodge Days, these treasures are made available for purchase, though Chuck isn't interested in profiting from them. He prefers to give his proceeds to the employee education fund at Timber Hills, for the benefit of the staff.

Chuck credits the telephone company for his own extensive education, even though he attended St. Cloud Teacher's College in 1950, and married a schoolteacher. So, it was natural for him to use his gifts and talents to help Timber Hills employees. "This place has been good to me. The living conditions are great, it has what I need, and there are lots of opportunities from concerts to card playing. I realize I can't do everything by myself and I know I'll be taken care of here. I can't say enough about the staff and the help."

Allison Schwaller Serves “Extended Family”

“I feel very blessed to have this opportunity to give back. It’s like extended family here. This place has become a huge family community.” - Allison Schwaller

Allison Schwaller smiles as she shares about a time when she and her father, Allan Nelson, walked around the grounds at Lake Minnetonka Shores. Everyone they passed seemed to greet Allan by name, so she asked, “Dad, how do you know all these people?” He answered, “Well, I don’t know. I went to this thing the other day. Then another day I went to this other thing...”

Allison realized that people still connected with her dad, even after he moved from the assisted living area in the Commons to the memory care area in the Arbor. “I like the integration of residents from different levels of care here. They don’t just stay in separate areas. Independent living residents help with assisted living or memory care residents. Even one of the kids in the daycare here always called him Grandpa. When people reach out to each other so personally it makes a lot of difference.”

Allan came to Lake Minnetonka Shores when his battle with Parkinson’s and dementia progressed beyond what could be managed at home. Fortunately, friends and family seemed to come along with him. “My dad had two special friends from church who visited him every Wednesday. One of them is a volunteer and would pop in to say hi at the end of his shifts,” says Allison. “I came about three times a week, too. We even had a huge party here for his 80th birthday.”

It makes sense that Allison’s friendships flourished, too. “I remember sitting there one day at dinner in the last weeks of my dad’s life,” she reminisces. “He wasn’t eating anything then, but we would just go to the dining room anyway. I looked around and thought, ‘Oh my gosh. I’m gonna miss these people. They’ve been such a huge part of our lives for so long.’”



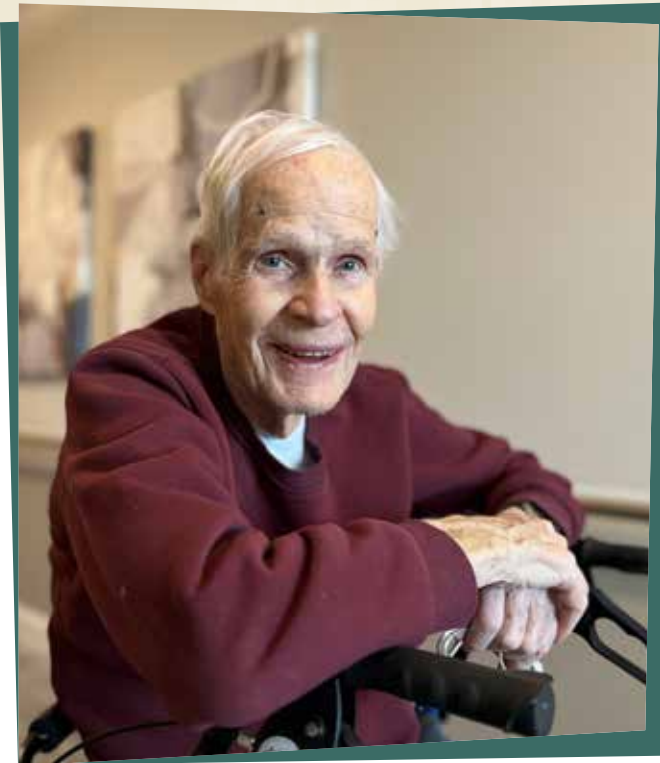
When Allan passed, Allison honored many employees through the Shining Star program. “There were just so many who did something special for my dad and us,” she states. “The strength and the love they shared made such a difference. Seeing a constant smile every time we walked through that door – even if I was crying – was such a blessing. And hearing the same voice calling, ‘Allan, you’re number one!’ always made my dad feel so good.”

Allison’s enthusiasm to give back to the community extended beyond Shining Star gifts. Her interest in serving residents was piqued when she saw a couple she had known for years who volunteered for the sheer joy of it – they did not have a relative in the community. “They help with activities in the summer and movie nights on Fridays,” explained Allison. “When I saw what they were doing I thought, that’s something I would like to do when the time comes. Here, I already know everybody. It just seemed natural to come back in.”

Now a trained and certified volunteer, Allison serves residents at least once a week, taking them to church on Sundays, going on walks, or joining them in chair yoga. “It’s great to see the staff and to feel like this is extended family. It’s such a great place.”

Hugh McElroy Spreads Light and Joy

"I know that some staff members are struggling, and I can see that the best way for me to care for them is through your program. Since some needs are greater than others, I make my gifts with the understanding that they would be shared among the employees as needed. It makes sense." - Hugh McElroy

The Cambridge Dictionary defines a luminary as "a person who inspires or influences others." For decades, Hugh McElroy has fit this definition in uncommon ways and paved the way for others to do the same.

After working at 3M for 34 years - and traveling the globe with them for the last 12 - Hugh experienced many different cultures. But, in 2000, a different kind of trip changed his life. A friend invited him on a 10-day mission trip to build homes in Guatemala, changing the lives of impoverished families. The experience impacted him so profoundly that, in 2013, he co-founded a faith-based organization to transform the lives of vulnerable girls in dire poverty. "If we want to positively influence them, we should live alongside them in the same facility during the school year," Hugh shares. "They need to have people supporting them, providing for them, and educating them."

For each of the last 23 years, Hugh spent at least three or four months in Guatemala with his ministry, Luminarias. "We want every girl who goes through our home to confidently be able to say our creed: 'We are women of dignity who will walk through our lives bringing light to our world with our authenticity, integrity, system of values, and faith in God without compromising ourselves for the approval of others.'" When several of these girls graduated from high school and began college in 2023, it was a proud moment for Hugh and Luminarias, as few girls in Guatemala attend school beyond sixth grade.

2023 brought about many changes for Hugh, too. After experiencing heart failure, and at the prompting of concerned family members, he moved from his house into an independent unit at Marvella, then into an assisted living unit a few months later. But his passion for helping others came right along with him every step of the way.

Hugh is keenly aware that charitable giving makes a big difference, and he gives through the Joy Society to assist employees of PHS who might face difficult circumstances.

Like Hugh McElroy, Miss Lillias Joy also invested in the education and character of young ladies, teaching mathematics at a girls' school in St. Paul, Minn., and Sunday school at House of Hope Presbyterian Church. Through her generous gift of land in 1952, Presbyterian Homes & Services broke ground on its first property, meeting the needs of those who had given themselves to a lifetime of service, specifically retired pastors and missionaries.

Mary Muilenburg Blesses Boutwells Landing Employees

“Most people, when considering a move into a community like Boutwells Landing, only evaluate the facility itself. We don’t often think about the staff - those individuals who do the everyday work and help meet our needs. It’s important that we support them. I want Boutwells Landing to continue being a strong resource and ministry.” – Mary Muilenburg

During most winters, Mary Muilenburg is on a golf course in Arizona each week, so, when back surgery and a resulting infection caused her to put the clubs away early this year, it was disappointing. Facing six weeks of rehabilitation and with her three children back in the Midwest, Mary was grateful for friends who carpooled the forty-minute drive to visit her in the hospital. Eventually, she could return to her Boutwells Landing home in Minnesota – and the closeness of family.

Months later, with golf still on hold, Mary plays a lot of mahjong and knits prayer shawls for others in her community who need a bit of encouragement. “I’m so glad when the kids or a neighbor can come over for a little bit. Even though my health is a little diminished now, I am still blessed with so many good things. I feel comfortable and safe here. This area is familiar to me and everything I need – the doctors, the dentist, the church – they’re all so close.”

Mary’s familiarity with the east side of St. Paul stems from living in its suburbs for decades. Her husband, John, worked at 3M for 39 years – 10 of which the family spent in Belgium – and added to the 13 moves their family made. “We were both born and raised in a little town in northwest Iowa, and our parents had never moved. So, who would think all this moving would happen in a career? We were both teachers in Iowa and then a friend of John’s introduced him to 3M. I became a stay-at-home mom, raising the kids while we moved from town to town, getting involved at the schools and churches, and doing lots of volunteering.”

After John retired, the couple moved to Sioux Falls, S.D. to be closer to John’s mother and the pheasant ranch that John co-owned. “When John died, I knew



I could not stay there by myself. The Christmas after he passed, I thought, ‘Well, there’s Boutwells Landing.’ We had visited friends here once, so I said to my son, ‘You know, maybe that’s where I need to go.’ We interviewed, looked around, and put my name on the list. The day we were staging my home to be sold we got the call that I could move in at the end of the month. My house sold in 36 hours, so I didn’t even have to put my things in storage!”

Since then, Mary has appreciated being closer to her sons – and within driving distance of her daughter in Illinois. “I’m so thankful for the whole concept of Presbyterian Homes and for Boutwells Landing. It’s a wonderful place for people with different needs and different locations, from the main building to the assisted living area. My neighbor just said to me the other night, ‘Aren’t we blessed to be in a place like Boutwells Landing?’”

“The whole system here is just wonderful,” Mary exclaims. “That’s why we decided to give to the Foundation – because it’s a good investment that helps staff and trains people to work here. I came from a very simple background, but we were always aware of how blessed we were. John and I supported charities that help people and it’s just part of our nature to give back.”

“When our daughter and her husband looked at the location of Orchard Path and the terms, they just signed us up and asked us to send a check!” exclaimed Ed. “They said, ‘Mom and Dad, we think we found the right place for you.’ And they were 100% right! We never even saw the place until we moved in – but they were right. This is a great place.”

It was 2018 when Ed and Elaine Brunkhorst decided to move back to Minnesota after living in Arizona for 15 years. “I loved my job so much that I didn’t want to retire, but our friends kept retiring and heading north for the summers. Our son and daughter thought it was a good idea that we move back, too.”

Ed and Elaine’s years leading up to this transition were filled with travel and adventure. After growing up in Red Wing, Minn., the couple married in 1955. Ed became a land manager for Dakota Electric and Elaine got her first job in a law office. She later accepted a position in labor relations for Northwest Airlines, enabling the Brunkhorsts to travel the world.

When they weren’t winging over an ocean, they traveled by a different kind of wing – a Honda Goldwing – or as Ed calls it, “the only motorcycle there is!” The couple toured the country and said the best ride they ever had was the Blue Ridge Parkway, traveling from Waynesboro, Va. to Asheville, N.C., on a 460-mile stretch with a 45-mph speed limit.

After their “first” retirement, Ed and Elaine moved to Arizona but continued to work part-time in other jobs. Ed worked at an auto auction and Elaine in a women’s clothing store. Elaine especially enjoyed

surprising customers from Minnesota when she recognized the names of their towns “back home.”

Ed and Elaine have been married for 68 years and now rely on wheelchairs for mobility. “We want to encourage people, though, so they know they can still do things even if they are confined to a wheelchair. We often go to Caribou Coffee across the way and to Target. We also like to ride around Cobblestone Lake, weather permitting. The other day we went to the bank nearby and Elaine cashed in \$28 worth of quarters that she won in bingo!”

“I live and breathe The Serenity Prayer,” Ed continues as he and Elaine recite it together. “God grant me the serenity to accept the things I cannot change, the courage to change the things I can, and the wisdom to know the difference.” Ed concludes, “It’s the wisdom part that’s most important.”

The Brunkhorsts have also adopted a saying: what good can you do? “We want to be a part of helping where there’s a need, even though we can’t afford to give a lot of money. When people give whatever they can, big or small, we know it adds up and makes a difference. We just like to help.”
